**I. Student ebook: *Descubre el español con Santillana***

Every student has access to an ebook. This resource allows the students to extend their learning beyond the school day and is accessible on smart devices, tablets, laptops, and computers.

Your student can use the ebook to practice listening, speaking, and reading skills in Spanish.

To log in, go to:

Enter your student's **user name** and **password** using their "active directory credentials" (computer log in) that have been assigned to them by the school system. Your school's Media Specialist or Technology Teacher can assist with your student's computer log in.

*(Note: The number "1" has been added to the end of the student passwords to work with the online system.)*



Click on the "ebook" icon.



Use the tool bar to advance and return to pages.



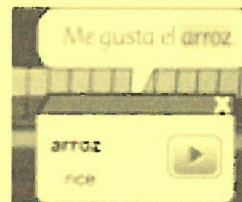
Click on the headset icon to listen.



Click on the movie camera icon to watch videos.



Click on a highlighted word to hear the Spanish pronunciation and to see its English meaning.



***Some suggested ways to use the ebook with your student.***

***Your student can...***

1. Practice listening skills by clicking on the headsets at the bottom of the ebook pages.
2. Practice reading the opening dialogue on the first pages of the current unit being studied.
3. Flip through the current unit to point to and identify vocabulary words in Spanish.
4. Retell a story from the unit.
5. Click on the highlighted words in the unit and practice pronunciation.
